Meaningful participation of local women and youth is ensured through inclusive and respectful approaches.

# MONSOON RAINS, USUALLY BRINGING LIFE SAVING WATER TO KERALA TURNED INTO TORRENT OF DESTRUCTION

When relentless rains poured for several days, state reservoirs overflow. Rivers and streams, once pristine, swept everything in the way. Thousands of homes inundated, families stranded, roads impassable, bridges overturned, and communications suspended, the floods is known to have claimed over 400 lives.

As the water levels receded, aid started pouring in, various Governmental and non-government avenues showed up to help, efforts to bring the state back to life intensified. We, United for Humanity, recognized the critical need for targeted interventions to address the overlooked and under-prioritised areas.

Slum areas in New Delhi, such as SHRAM VIHAR, SOUTH DELHI, and GAFFAR MANZIL, are characterized by a lack of basic amenities, making it difficult for residents to manage their daily lives during harsh weather conditions. UFH organized a collection drive in winter 2018 to provide warm clothes, blankets, shoes, and other essential items to those in need. To further amplify our efforts, UFH collaborated with Aaghaaz e Taleem, a leading non-governmental organization (NGO) in Delhi. The joint initiative aimed to provide relief to those struggling to cope with the harsh climate.

The joint effort resulted in the delivery of 100 Fresh Jackets, Blankets and Clothing Materials, distributed to the people in need, ensuring they had adequate protection from the cold. Special care was taken to provide blankets, warm clothes, and shoes to infants and children.

# FROM HEARTBREAK TO HOPE: A LEAP OF FAITH

IN FEBRUARY 2019, A CHILLING COLD SWEEPED THROUGH KASHMIR, BUT IT WAS NOT JUST THE WEATHER THAT WAS UNFORGIVING. FOR A FIVE-MONTH-OLD GIRL NAMED AYESHA, THE COLD WAS A CONSTANT REMINDER OF HER FRAGILE EXISTENCE. BORN WITH A VENTRICULAR SEPTAL DEFECT (VSD), AYESHA'S LIFE HUNG IN THE BALANCE, AND HER FAMILY WAS STRUGGLING TO FIND THE FINANCIAL RESOURCES TO SAVE HER.

AYESHA'S FAMILY, LIVING IN KASHMIR, WAS DEVASTATED BY THE DIAGNOSIS. WITH LIMITED ACCESS TO MEDICAL CARE AND FINANCIAL RESOURCES, THEY WERE AT A LOSS FOR WHAT TO DO. WITH HOPE OF GIVING THEIR DAUGHTER THE LIFE SHE DESERVED THEY TOOK A LEAP OF FAITH AND TURNED TO THE NATIONAL CAPITAL. THAT WAS WHEN THEY REACHED OUT TO UNITED FOR HUMANITY FOUNDATION (UFH), DEDICATED TO PROVIDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO FAMILIES IN NEED OF MEDICAL CARE.

UFH, RECOGNIZING THE URGENCY OF AYESHA'S SITUATION, SPRANG INTO ACTION, TO RAISE FUNDS FOR HER TREATMENT, KNOWING THAT EVERY MOMENT COUNTED. AS AYESHA WAS FIGHTING FOR HER LIFE THE FAMILY MET WITH ANOTHER DISTRESS AS THE HOSPITAL REFUSED TO LET THEM MEET THEIR LITTLE GIRL DUE TO THE OUTSTANDING FEE, AND TIME WAS RUNNING OUT.

UNDERSTANDING THE GRAVITY OF THE SITUATION, TEAM UFH WORKED TIRELESSLY TO GATHER RESOURCES AND COORDINATE WITH THE HOSPITAL TO ENSURE THAT AYESHA RECEIVED THE NECESSARY MEDICAL ATTENTION. THANKS TO THE GENEROSITY OF UFH'S SUPPORTERS, DONORS AND THE LOCAL COMMUNITY, AYESHA'S FAMILY RECEIVED THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE THEY SO DESPERATELY NEEDED. THE FUNDS WERE USED TO CLEAR THE OUTSTANDING HOSPITAL BILL, ALLOWING AYESHA TO REUNITE WITH HER PARENTS AND THE NEW LIFE THAT AWAITS HER.

FAST FORWARD TO TODAY, AND AYESHA IS THRIVING. HER TREATMENT WAS SUCCESSFUL, AND SHE IS NOW A HEALTHY AND HAPPY CHILD. HER FAMILY, TOO, HAS BEEN TRANSFORMED BY THE EXPERIENCE, WITH A NEWFOUND SENSE OF HOPE AND RESILIENCE. AYESHA'S STORY IS A TESTAMENT TO THE POWER OF COMMUNITY AND THE IMPACT THAT CAN BE MADE WHEN PEOPLE COME TOGETHER TO SUPPORT THOSE IN NEED.

AS WE REFLECT ON AYESHA'S JOURNEY, WE ARE REMINDED OF THE IMPORTANCE OF OUR MISSION AT UFH. HER STORY IS NOT JUST ONE OF SURVIVAL BUT ALSO OF HOPE AND DETERMINATION.





# A TASTE OF HOPE IN MAHUADANAR VILLAGE

In the heart of Jharkhand, a small village called Mahuadanar was struggling to survive. Food insecurity has become a harsh reality for many families. It was here that our team, United For Humanity (UFH), decided to intervene. We embarked on a mission to bring hope to the starving families. Our goal was to distribute three months' worth of ration to 46 families who were on the brink of desperation. The village was disconnected from the rest of the world, with no reliable network or infrastructure to speak of.



Upon arrival, we were met with a sea of empty faces, eyes sunken from hunger and despair. The villagers, mostly farmers and labourers, had been struggling to make ends meet due to the lack of facilities and resources. But our work didn't stop there. We knew that food was just the beginning. We needed to build a bridge between the social workers in the area and the families in need. We organised community meetings, where we listened to their stories and addressed their concerns to identify the root causes of food insecurity and develop sustainable solutions.

The project was a testament to the power of collaboration. Together, we were able to break down the barriers of discrimination that had long plagued the village, where certain castes and communities were often excluded from aid.

In the end, our food drive benefited 271 people, giving them a chance to rebuild their lives.

The villagers, once forgotten, were now seen and heard. And as long as we continued to work together, there was hope that one day, their village would be a place where everyone had access to the basic necessities of life.

# A STORY OF TRANSFORMATION: BRIJWA'S DAUGHTER FINDS HOPE



In her own words, she shared, "Agar aaj zinda hun to sirf UFH ki madad kin wajah se warna apni Maa ki trah mar gai hoti." ("If I am alive today, it is only because of the help from UFH; otherwise, I would have died like my mother.")

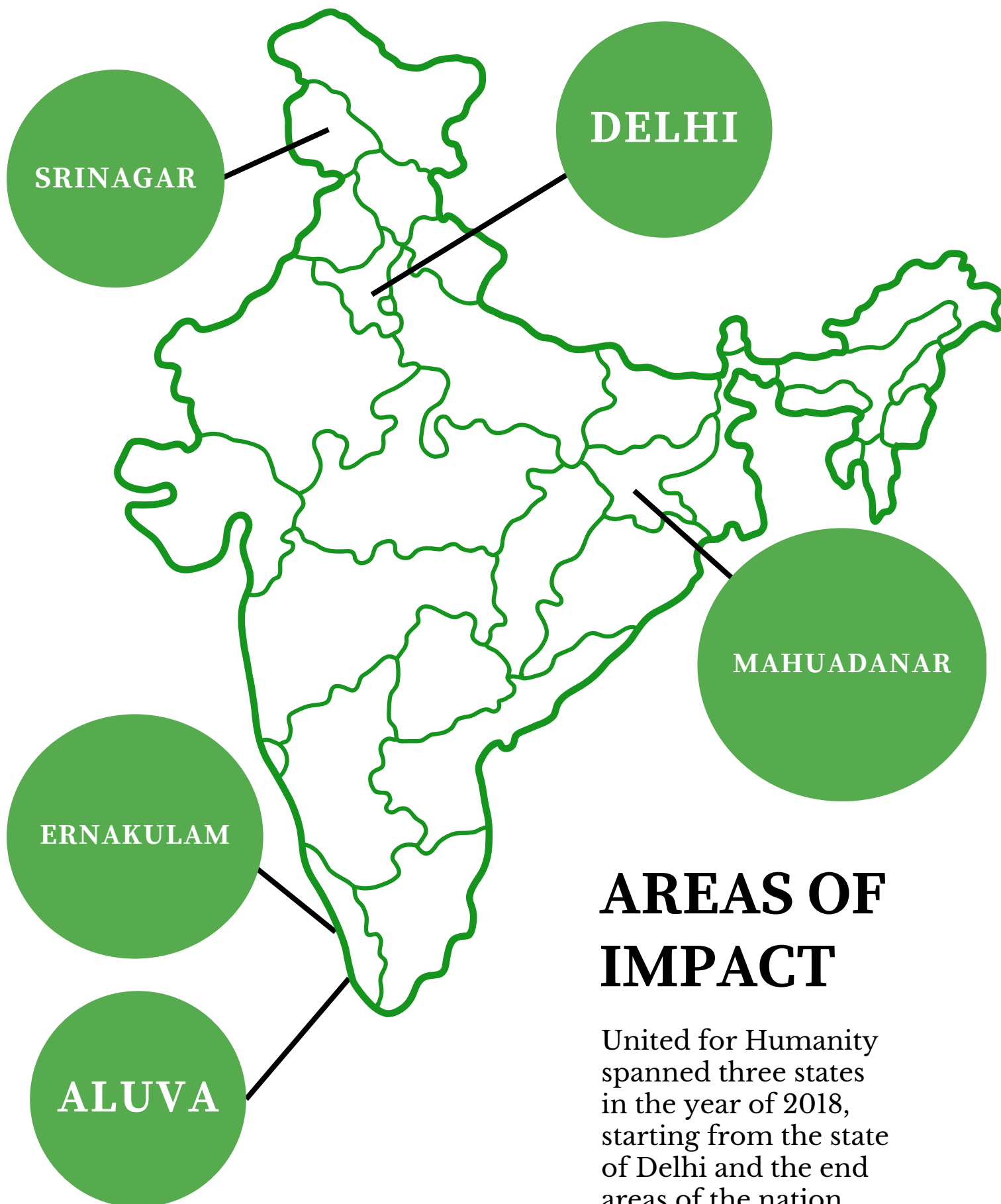
In a small village in Jharkhand, a woman known as Brijwa's daughter experienced a devastating loss when her mother succumbed to starvation. The family had long struggled with extreme poverty, often unable to secure even one proper meal a day.

However, everything changed when the UFH (United for Humanity) team intervened. Upon learning about her dire situation, the team provided her with six months' worth of rations, ensuring she had enough food to sustain herself during this challenging period. But their support did not end there. The UFH team also connected her with a local organization dedicated to improving livelihoods.

Through this connection, Brijwa's daughter received training in stitching and other skills, allowing her to earn a stable income. With the support of the local organization, she now has a steady source of income and can afford two proper meals a day.

This story is a testament to the profound impact that timely intervention and community support can have on individuals facing extreme hardship. Brijwa's daughter's life has been transformed, giving her hope and a future she never thought possible.



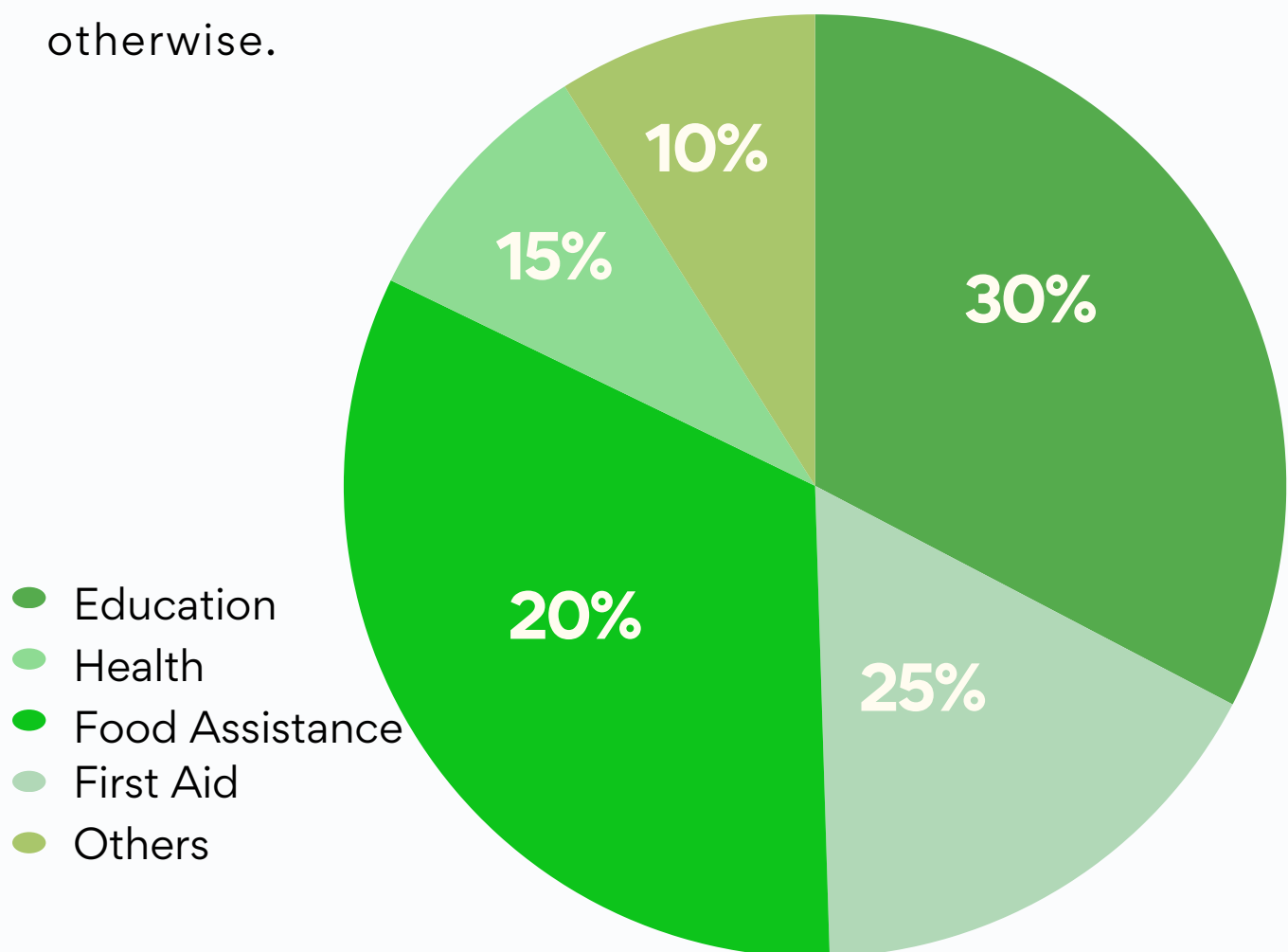


## AREAS OF IMPACT

United for Humanity invested in a strategic approach to address critical needs, after detailed research. UFH formulated targeted interventions, aiming the areas which weren't being covered otherwise.



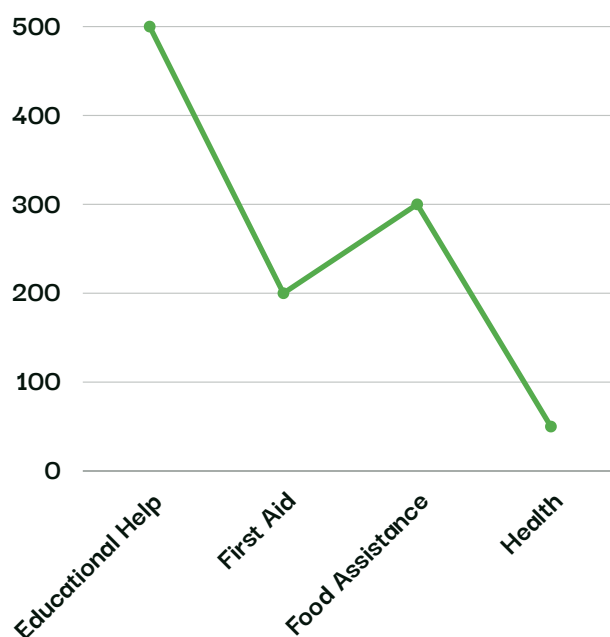

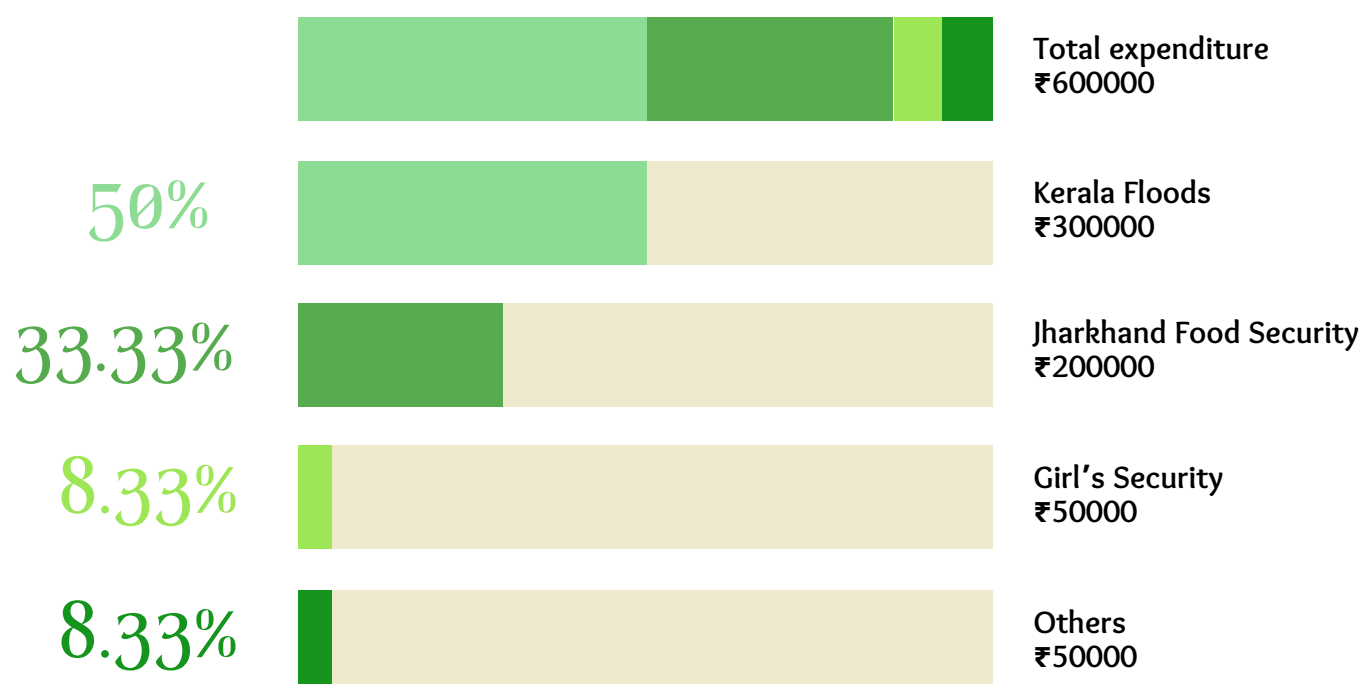
